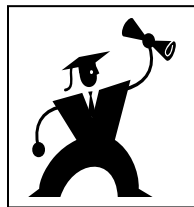
### Welcome New Neighbors

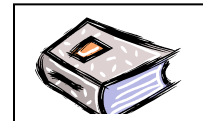
### Congratulations!

### Woods of Parkview Book Club

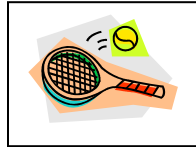

## “New” Pool News



Renovations to the pool are largely complete, and it looks great! The renovations included resurfacing both pools, including new tile, lights, and coping; along with many improvements to the pump room. Concrete decking which had cracked or subsided has been replaced, and repairs are being made to the spring board and guard stands.

This has been a huge project, and is a success story for our neighborhood.

Thanks to everyone who gave their support and worked to accomplish this goal.

Our swim team will begin using the pool for practices in May. **Opening day** for all swim/tennis members is Thursday, May 24<sup>th</sup>. There will be an **ice cream party** at the pool on that day – watch the website and neighborhood bulletin board for more details.

The **Memorial Day Party**, is scheduled for Monday, May 28, 5 pm. Bring your own beverage and a side dish (chips, salad, dessert, etc.) to share; the swim/tennis club will provide hamburgers and hotdogs

**Pool party reservations** are now being made directly through Positively Pools. You may contact Honey, at 7/972-3111, to make arrangements. As in the past, the party host will pay a \$25 non-refundable fee, due at the time of reservation, and will pay \$20/hour per lifeguard. Zero-20 guests require 1 lifeguard, 21-60 guests require 2 lifeguards, and 60+ guests require 3 lifeguards. You can log on to the [woodsofparkview.com](http://woodsofparkview.com) website for reservation forms and to check availability, but times and dates must be confirmed with Positively Pools.

A copy of the current pool rules is also available on the website, covering the rules and regulations regarding private parties at the pool.
