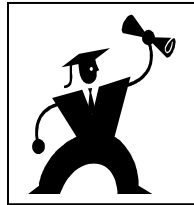

## Pool Dates & Hours

Starting **May 1, 2008**, the pool is available for parties. See below for information regarding pool party reservations.

**May 17, 2008 (Saturday): Opening day** for all swim/tennis members, pool open 11am to 9pm.

**May 18, 2008 (Sunday)** – Pool open 1pm to 8pm

May 19, 2008 (Monday) – Pool Closed

May 20, 2008 (Tuesday) – Pool Closed

**May 21, 2008 (Wednesday):** Pool open 4pm to 8pm to celebrate the last day of school. Ice cream party at 4pm.

**May 22, 2008** – Pool opens at 11 am, and full time staffed summer pool hours begin.

**May 26, 2008 (Monday): Memorial Day Cookout at 5pm.** Bring your own beverage and a side dish (chips, salad, dessert, etc.) to share; the swim/tennis club will provide barbeque and buns.

**Summer hours** are: Mon-Sat, 11am to 9pm; and Sunday, 1pm to 8pm. These hours are in effect from May 22 through August 10, 2008.

Once school begins (August 11), the pool is open in the afternoons (4-8pm) and on weekends, including Fridays, until the end of August.

In September, the pool is open weekends only: Fri, 4-9pm, Sat 11am-9pm; and Sunday 1-8pm, until September 14. The pool will be open Labor Day, September 1, 11am-9pm. After September 14, the pool is open for

private parties only. The pool will be closed for winter on September 30, 2008.

**Pool party reservations** are now being made through Konnie Torbahn 7/381-8001, or [ktorbahn@comcast.net](mailto:ktorbahn@comcast.net). As in the past, the party host will pay a \$25 non-refundable fee, due at the time of reservation, and will pay \$20/hour per lifeguard. Zero-20 guests require 1 lifeguard, 21-40 guests require 2 lifeguards, and 40+ guests require 3 lifeguards. You can log on to the [WOPHA.com](http://WOPHA.com) website for reservation forms and to check availability, but times and dates must be confirmed with Konnie.

A copy of the current pool rules is also available on the website, covering the rules and regulations regarding private parties at the pool.

## Membership Dues Update

Annual dues were due March 31, 2008, for the 2008 membership year. Full Member dues are \$525 this year; Social dues are \$95. Make checks payable to WOPHA and send to our new mailbox: 1 Planters Drive, Lilburn, GA, 30047.

Per the Declaration of Covenants, if dues are not paid by May 1, 2008 homeowners will be charged a late fee equal to \$10.00 or 10% of the amount due, and interest of 18%/annum shall accrue from the due date. If dues are still not paid by June 1, 2008, the matter will be turned over to our attorney for collection.
