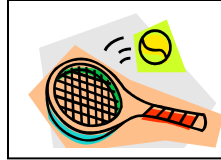
Woods of Parkview Swim and Tennis Events

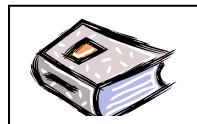
Swim/Tennis Referrals

Woods of Parkview Book Club

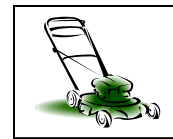

The party host will pay a \$25 non-refundable fee, due at the time of reservation, and will pay \$20/hour per lifeguard: 0-20 guests require 1 lifeguard, 21-60 guests require 2 lifeguards, and 60+ guests require 3 lifeguards.
